Commonly known as the adventure capital of the country, the Arenal area has some of the most adrenaline

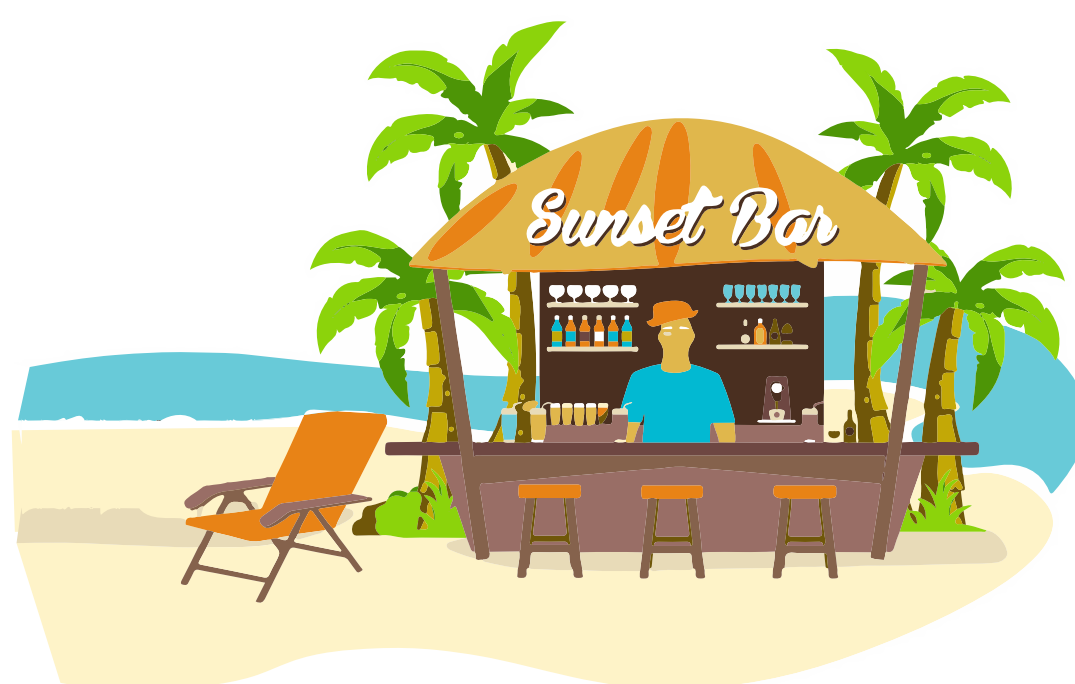
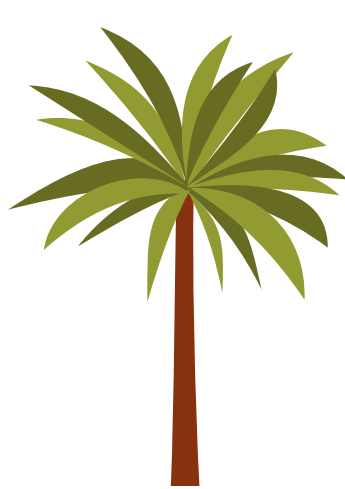


San Jose

The most common dish is Gallo Pinto which consists of rice mixed with black beans and drink a cup of coffee or fresh fruit juice.



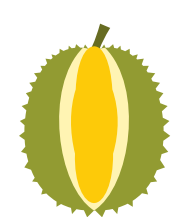
Best Times to Visit

From mid-December to April (the dry season). This peak tourist season boasts plenty of sunshine making it an ideal time for exploring rainforests and lounging on beaches.

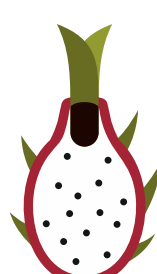

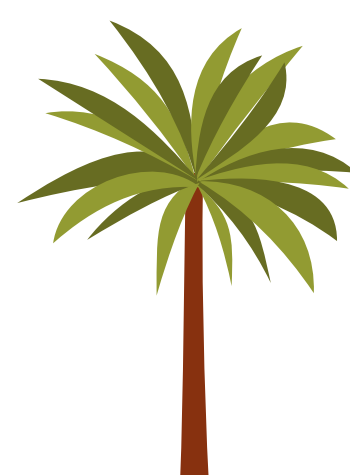
